

Sermon application question- as many groups are on break for the summer feel free to use these as a personal guide as you process the word of God and how it applies to your life.

1. We keep coming back to the idea of sitting in front of the Lord and saying HERE I AM... are you continuing to do that? Has the Lord directed you towards any specific actions or conversations? If there has been a clear ask, how have you responded to the ask?
2. The Hebrews have the moment where they believe they are going to be freed and they worship God because of the future promise. This is a moment where they feel heard and understood. Have you had any specific moments in your life where you feel like God has specifically seen and heard you? If so remind yourself what that moment was like.
3. As Moses and Aaron commanded Pharaoh to let the people go for a few days to worship God Pharaoh's response was, "who is the God that I should listen to him?" Pharaoh in turn turns the people against Moses and Pharaoh by demanding bricks without giving them straw. This works and the Hebrews get angry at Moses, are you often tempted to blame the wrong people for problems and sin in your life?
4. Do you tend to think of the Christian life as one where material and physical blessing are rewards for obedience? How can you remind yourself that scripture says multiple times that being a Christian will be costly and painful at times?
