Exodus 15

1. Spend time reading Exodus 15 this week in reflection of this past Sunday.
2. In verse 1 it says, "I will sing to the Lord *FOR*." What makes you sing to the Lord? Take some time to think through all that God has done in your life and take time to thank him!
3. We talked about the fact that salvation is a gift from God, yet we still have a part to play in obeying and following God. Has God been asking you to do anything lately that might feel a bit daunting and overwhelming?
4. Why is it so hard to think about a God who at times will bring destruction and hardship as an act of judgment and justice? Do you have any holdups believing that God will uphold his justice as he brings salvation?
5. What are the old task masters that seem to regularly call out to you? Come back to insecurity? Come back to jealousy? Come back to pride? Come back to doubt? Come back to fear? How can you actively say no to that old task masters call?
6. Are you in a season of (Elim) deep joy and contentment? If so, recognize this as a gift from God and thank him for it!
