PROCESS AND APPLY THIS WEEK'S MESSAGE

Exodus 31

- How are you doing this week? Do you need prayer for anything specific during this time?
- This week we are discussing how God gifts individuals with specific aptitudes and talents. Reflect this week on what those might be in your life and how God might want to use those for His glory.
- In Exodus chapter 25-30 God instructs Israel to build a Tabernacle — this would have required a huge amount of work. Yet in Exodus 31, God commands His people to take rest seriously, and enjoy a day each week to be satisfied in Him and to cease from working. How is the balance of working *for* God and resting *in* God in your life?
- Jesus has completed the work of Salvation on the cross for us, so we don't need to work to receive it. However, the Bible says that God has created us to do good works (Eph 2:10). Reflect this week upon how our work is not a means of striving for God's love, but a way of responding to God's love for us.
