- 3) Why do you think the disciples kept missing what Jesus had planned for them?
- 4) Read Acts 1:7-11. If you were there in that moment with the other disciples, how do you think you would have reacted?
- 5) How did you respond the last time you discovered that your plan for your future, and God's plan for your future were not the same?
- 6) Describe what Jesus is calling the disciples to do? What's the most challenging thing for you about being a witness? What's the role of God's Spirit in what he has called us to do?

## Apply

Having "something to say" is both a joy and a daily struggle for most of us. We wrestle with saying the right and timely thing to the people God has in our lives. We know our message is not culturally popular and most of us have experienced what we would categorize as personal failures in our efforts to be a witness for Jesus and the good news.
