- 4) Why do we so often resist giving God control over things in our lives?
- 5) According to Jesus in the Sermon on the Mount, what is the benefit to you in trusting that God's control is good? Can you share a time when you experienced the goodness of His sovereignty?

- 7) Pray with each other over those places in your life that you still have issues with gladly giving God His rightful control.
