- 2) Was there something in the message that grabbed your attention? What was it and why did this speak to you?

Explore

- 3) Read Matthew 6:5-8. What's the problem with praying or practicing the spiritual disciplines in front of others to be noticed?

- 4) Read Matthew 6:9-15. According to the model prayer, how are we to address God? What's the significance in this?

- 5) What does it look like to pray for His kingdom to come and His will to be done in our country, city, neighborhood or home?

- 6) What piece of this prayer is typically missing in your prayer life? Why is that a challenge for you?

Apply

As a group, try using this model prayer together. Take one theme at a time and pray that out, then move on to the next subject.

This week, try using this model of praying once a day in your personal life of prayer.
